



Knowing your tables is a really important and fundamental skill for many areas of maths.

The 99 Club is going really well and everyone is enjoying the weekly challenge. The children (up until 99 club) sit a 10 minute quiz every week. Each time the children pass a level they get a colourful badge, as designed by our student council.

Here are a few things you may not know:

- Your children should be bringing home their answer sheet every week, (if they haven't moved up a level then this will show you what they need to work on) and a blank copy to practise on at home.
- If they have moved up, children will also have a copy of the next level for them to practise at home.
- There is a 3 week rotation to the tests so children won't sit the same quiz each week.
- Remember little and often rather than cramming once a week is more effective – use the sums on the sheet as a focus.
