

### English

In English, we will be writing a letter to the Roman army to persuade them that we are suitable candidates to become soldiers. We will then be creating and writing instructions for a Celtic broth and writing a non-chronological report about Roman houses. We will also be writing a recount as Boudicca of a day at war with the Romans.

### D.T.

We will be learning all about different types of Roman catapults and will be designing and creating our own! We will learn about the different ways to reinforce and strengthen the structures before testing the functionality of our products.

## Autumn 2 I Am Warrior!

### Reading

This half term we will be reading 'The Thieves of Ostia' by Caroline Lawrence. Join Flavia and her friends in this Roman mystery story as we investigate the many disappearances in the town of Ostia

### PSHE- Jigsaw

In this unit we celebrate differences. We learn about judging (or rather not judging) a book by its cover and celebrate our individuality.

### Geography

We are comparing and contrasting physical aspects of Italy and Britain, as well as looking at Hillfort locations and street maps of Rome.

### Maths

In Maths, we will be focusing on addition and subtraction before investigating measure. This will involve calculating the perimeter of shapes and converting measures. We will then begin to look at multiplication and division.

### Science
