Year 1 have been putting their science skills to the test this half term and have successfully planted, nurtured and grown bean plants! The children have been working scientifically to observe



and record changes. Their bean plant now measures an amazing 67cm! Mr Hughes and Miss McNally extremely proud of our Year 1's and their knowledge on all things plants.





Year 2 were visited by St Austell Tennis Club for a very special tennis lesson. The

coach took the children through some activities that helped them focus in on their tennis skills. The had some mini competitions and were really focussed on getting the ball to their targets. All of the children thoroughly enjoyed this session and are eager to get out playing more tennis soon.





Year 3 have been studying Jackson Pollock, an abstract artist. They mixed primary colours together to make secondary colours, made different shades and tints by adding black or white, and experimented with contrasting colours. They should all be extremely proud of their art work - it is amazing! They will use these lessons to create a final piece in the style of Jackson Pollock.





In science, Year 4 have been looking at how toothpaste can protect our teeth. The children covered eggs in toothpaste then placed them into vinegar. They watched to see if the toothpaste could protect the egg from the harmful effects of the acid.

On Tuesday, Year 5 had a fantastic afternoon at St Austell Fire Station. The children attended a Junior Life Skills Session where they took part in a range of workshops learning about fire safety, water safety, rail safety, CPR and much more. The children thoroughly enjoyed it!

In Maths they have been looking at shapes, The children have enjoyed making the most of the sunny spells and dodging the showers.


