

## English

In English, we are:

- learning and writing the story of Sgt Stubby
- writing instructions to give directions
- writing letters to persuade influential people to improve our locality

## Maths

Maths will be taught using the Singapore Maths scheme. Our main focus for this half term is addition and subtraction of two digit numbers and applying their skills to a range of problem solving activities.

## Science

In science, we will be focusing on everyday materials. We will be looking at the properties of a range of materials, and asking which material is best for which purpose. We will also be having a focus on the use of plastics and the impact on the environment.

## Geography

Our topic is largely geography based this half term. We will be taking a closer look at our locality and the facilities it has. We will use maps to follow routes around school and the Mount Charles area. We will also be creating imaginary maps and towns using symbols and co-ordinates.

## RE
