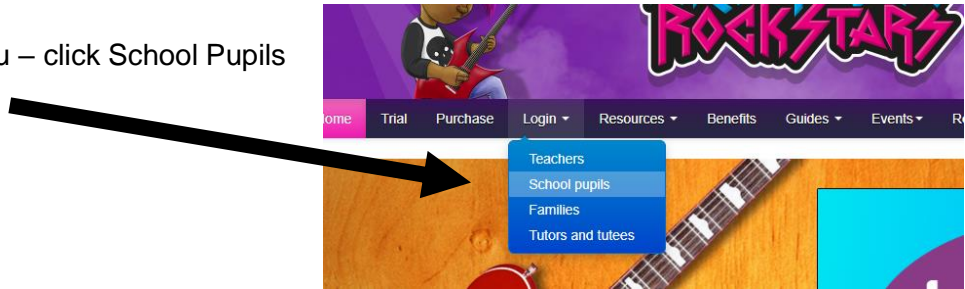


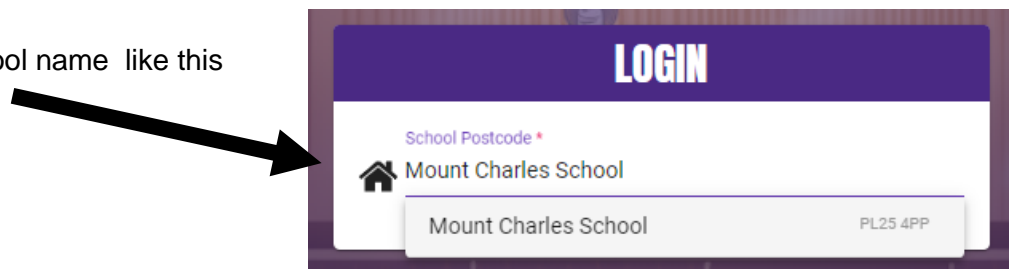


- 1) Open a web browser and go to [www.trockstars.com](http://www.trockstars.com) - the menus may look slightly different on different devices – look for the menu icon to open the menus. Or Scan the QR code – follow the link and go to step 4.

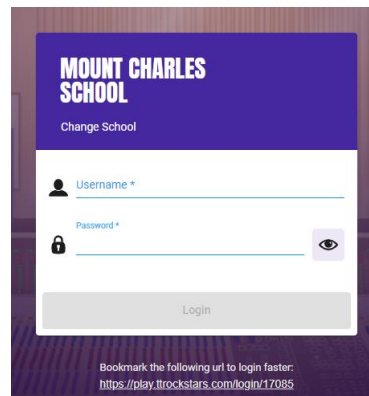
- 2) In the Login menu – click School Pupils



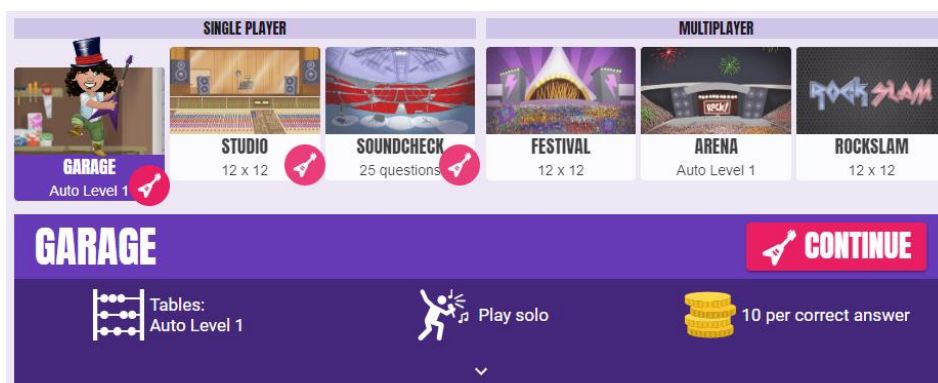
- 3) Type the school name like this

- 5) Play any of the various games. For newer / first time users the 'Garage' or 'Arena Auto' level is a great place to start.

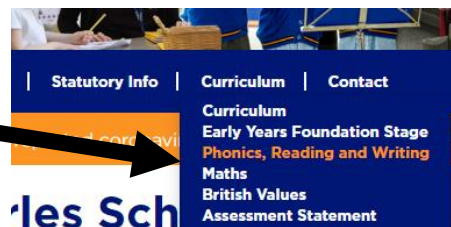




Scan the QR Code and follow the link to the AR Website and go to step 4. **Or:**

- 2) Click the Accelerated Reader link in the menu at the side



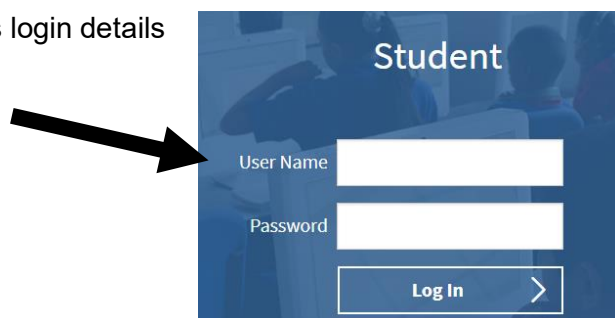
- 3) Follow the link to Home Page of accelerated reader

2) Click the 'Sign In'

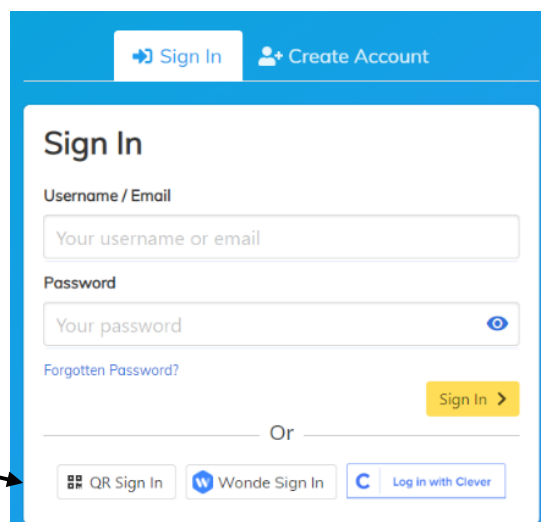


3) There are two ways to login.
