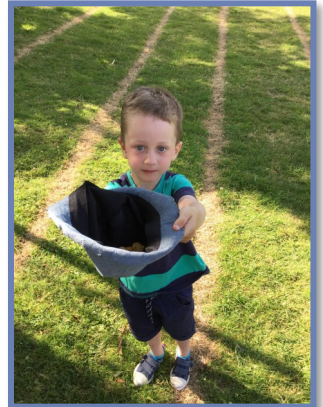




# MEET & GREET
