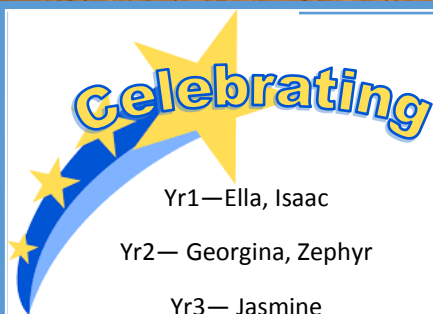
Our lost property collection has grown again. Do come and collect any items belonging to your child. Please ensure all items of clothing are named so we can reunite them with their owner!
