On Monday, in a special remembrance assembly, we celebrated the service and bravery of our armed forces, past and present. Children

of serving military personnel stood up and proudly told the whole assembly about their parents, the roles they have in the services and what it is like to be part of a military family.

On Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup>, our Year 6 children took part in an evacuee experience as an introduction to their topic A Child's War. For part of the day, they walked up to the train station and imagined what it would have been like for the children who arrived here as they were evacuated to the area, what they would have thought and how they would have felt. Our children really looked the part in fantastic costumes!







On Tuesday 5th November, Year 2 travelled back in time and walked through the Victorian Streets at Flambards for their Street Detective topic. They explored the old shops, walked through houses and schools and found out they used horse and carriage as a mode of transport! They discussed and compared Victorian times to now.





On Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November, EYFS visited Kingswood to engage the children in their new theme 'Why do squirrels hide their nuts?' The children collected autumn treasures and discussed what can be seen and heard in the woods. This was the children's first trip away from school. 13th December - Christmas jumper day. Wear a Christmas jumper to school in return for a £1 donation for Save the Children.


18th December - Christmas Dinner day. Normal school uniform, however children are invited to bring a Christmas hat or head piece to wear at lunch time.

are not being used as a polling station for the general election on 12th December.






