English

Our English will focus on three genres this term.

A Non-fiction text based on a book called 'Transport'. It will link nicely to our trip to Flambards as well as our excursion around the local area.

Our fiction unit will be based on Little Red Riding Hood. The children will explore the text looking for a wide variety of vocabulary and will look at building sentences using adjectives, adverbs and some conjunctions. They will then apply all they have learnt to retell it in their own words.

Our third text will be poetry. We will explore the story poem 'Tell me a dragon.' This book is bursting with rich vocabulary and descriptions, which will help the children, build their own poems.

Music

Music lessons this term will involve singing and the musical preparation for this years Nativity.

Our Religious Education study will be looking at the Christian festival of Christmas, which will also link nicely to our school Nativity.


PSHE- Jigsaw scheme
