Writing

We will be writing a description based on the view from the crow's nest on Ernest Shakelton's boat. We will be writing a diary entry from the perspective of crewmember on Shakelton's boat. As well, we will write a scientific report based on a made up animal that would survive in the Artic environment.

Maths

Maths will be taught using White Rose teaching units. This half term we will be converting units of measure, investigating properties of shape and looking at algebra.

Music

We will be exploring different apps and making programs which we can use to compose music.

PE

Through gymnastics, we will be matching and mirroring body shapes and practising counter-balancing skills to develop short gymnastic routines.

Reading

Our class text will be 'Shackleton's Journey' by William Grill. We will be continuing our retrieving, inference and fluency skills through a range of whole class, shared and individual reading and discussion of the continuity of

Science
