Well done to our St Austell District Athletics field events team. Two golds, one silver and four bronze medals.

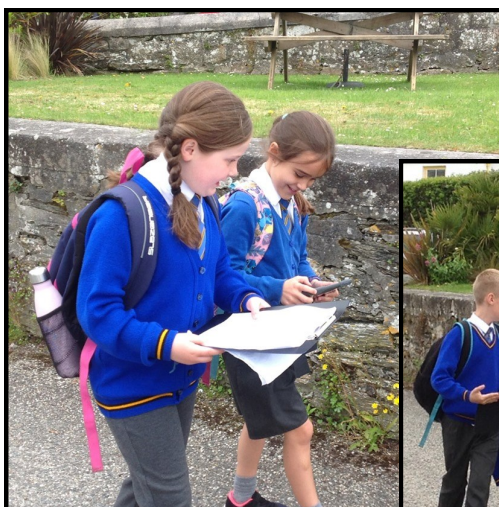

Field

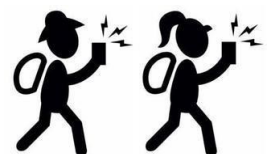

Is your child in Year 2?

If your child is currently in Year 2, they will be entitled to free school meals under the Universal Free School Meals Scheme, (UFSM) This is a provision for all children in Years R, 1 & 2.

When your child moves into Year 3, they will no longer be entitled to UFSM. However, they may be eligible for free meals under the means-tested Free School Meals (FSM) scheme. This is normally the case for children whose families are in receipt of certain benefits. Please speak to the school office if you think your child should be able to receive FSM in Year 3. The office can check our records and answer any questions you may have.
