

Literacy

We will start the term by drawing and writing about our friends and family.

We will be exploring many stories about friendship including 'Lost and Found', 'Have you filled a bucket today?' and the Aesop fable 'The Lion and the Mouse'.

Phonics

We will be following the Read Write Inc. phonics program and will be introducing Set 1 Speed Sounds. We will be meeting F-R-E-D who will help us develop our skills in oral blending.

Communication and Language

We will be using our listening skills to enjoy stories linked to our theme. We will be discussing the characters, settings and events in each of the stories we read together.

We will be learning to work with a partner and to find our 'big voice' when speaking in front of others.

When we 'virtually' meeting new members of staff, we will be asking them questions to find out about their role in school. We will use question words such as who, why, what, how and when.

We shall also be learning new songs and rhymes.

Maths

We shall be exploring numbers from 0-5. We will be reading the number, counting the number of objects and writing the numeral.

We will be sorting objects into two groups and comparing quantities using the vocabulary 'more' and 'less'.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will also be developing our fine motor skills through our daily Finger Gym sessions.
